# LATE ARRIVALS

Foundation 2 (Dove, Magpie and Woodpecker) children are taken into school at 8.45am by their teachers. If you arrive after the classes have gone in you need to take your child to the School Office to be taken through to their class. An increasing number of children are arriving late to Foundation and this is causing a great deal of disruption to the start of the day. Please try and arrive on time so that your child has the best start.

# PARKING AT WEST OAK NURSING HOME

The road leading down to West Oak Nursing Home is a private road and should never be used by parents to park in. The Administrator at West Oak is extremely concerned about the number of cars driving up and down the road and there are children running all around. Please do not use this road to park in and do not let your children run around unsupervised in busy areas.

# F1 ADMISSION FOR SEPTEMBER 2014

Our part-time places operate on a one-term entry, so places are offered to children in the September after their third birthday. If you have a child whose date of birth is between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2010 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2011 and you are interested in them attending our Foundation Stage on a part-time basis next September, please ask for a registration card at the School Office. We are holding an Open Evening for prospective parents of children who will be 3 before 31<sup>st</sup> August 2014 on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March from 4.00pm to 5.30pm - if you or anyone you know would like to come along you are most welcome. You can bring your children with you.

#### SCHOOL LUNCH PAYMENT

We have been informed by Caterlink that all lunch debts must be cleared by Wednesday  $1^{st}$  April or else school is liable for these. Please ensure you keep a check on your child's account so that they do not run into debt. We send out debt letters every two weeks but should not really have to do this - you are responsible for maintaining your child's school lunch account and should not be sending them in if you have not credited their account with sufficient funds. If your child has school lunch every day you need to credit their account by £9.75 every week - before they have the lunches is preferable!
