Start and End of the School Day

Generally things have been going much better this week, however, we would very much appreciate that parents from Year 1 and Year 2 leave the site as soon as possible after their child has joined the line with their teacher and learning support assistant, to reduce congestion. Please do not wait until the line goes inside. Children coming into FS2 will now be going into their classrooms straight away so please leave as soon as you have said goodbye. Thank you so much for your cooperation.

Mobile Phones on Site

I have noticed a number of adults coming on to the school site using their mobile phones. We do not allow mobile phones to be used on the school site for **<u>safeguarding reasons</u>**. Please refrain from using your phone, taking photographs or filming videos. It is very important that your child is greeted with a smile and a conversation and not someone who is on the phone. Thank you.

Stranger Danger and Safety Outside

I have been informed of a very strange and upsetting event that occurred at Morrisons in Woosehill recently (you may already be aware). A stranger was offering sweets to school children and a child from Emmbrook Senior School accepted one; later on they reported feeling unwell. This has been reported to the police. Mr McSweeney shared this information

a student here has informed us there was a man outside Morrisons in Woosehill this morning giving away sweets. This student has eaten a sweet and is now feeling unwell.

There was also an incident at St Paul's Junior School yesterday: Mrs Taylor shared this information with the parents:

a man was seen behaving suspiciously and after he left, we found drugs paraphernalia in the bushes at the far end of the field. This has been removed and the police and WBC notified but if this is an area you allow your children to use out of school hours, please impress upon them the importance of leaving immediately if they see anyone behaving suspiciously and that they should avoid picking up anything that might be dangerous.

If your child reports any concerns of this nature, please call Thames Valley Police on 101 and report the matter immediately, letting us know too.

All our children are too young to be out without the supervision of an adult they know and trust.

Naming Uniform and Kits

PE Kit and PE Days

Please can children in Year 1 and Year 2 come to school in their PE kits on their PE days and come in school uniform if they have an after school sports club. They will change into the kit at the end of the school day.



Using cars to travel to school and Parking issues and restrictions

Parking is very difficult around our school as there are over 700 children arriving at three different settings. We always advise walking, scooting or cycling to school if possible. We realise many people cannot do this as they love too far away or have to carry on to work or other schools after drop off. Perhaps you could park further away and walk a short distance to school to reduce congestion. This morning it was reported to me that some parents were parking in the car park and on the pavements of the elderly care home West Oak. There was an emergency ambulance on site and the barrier was raised. The barrier is usually down preventing cars from entering but there has been a malfunction. PLEASE do not park in the vicinity of the care home.

Likewise the carpark for Murray House is private property so please do not park there either.

Jeans for Genes Day ~ Friday 17th September 2021

Each year we have a Jeans for Genes Day; this term it will be on Friday 17th September 2021. The children can come to school in jeans and a jumper or t-shirt and bring in a recommended donation of £1 to support scientific research into genetic disorders. They do not need to wear their school jumpers and cardigans unless they want to.





Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one sessions, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
