Smashing our target of £2000 out of the park! Soon we will be at our goal of £4,400 for our outdoor gym equipment!




In School today ...

Cost of living help and support

The <u>cost of living help hub</u> has been updated with new schemes and projects to help you this winter.

There's nine top tips for you to access help if you need it. And if none of these apply to you, check more than <u>90 ways to save from Martin Lewis</u>.

We know Christmas can be expensive so save this email in case you want to access any of this support in the new year.

£400 energy payments

Make sure your energy provider is making <u>Energy Bill Support Scheme payments</u>, £400 between October and March. Contact your supplier if you've not received your payments.

Pension credits

Check if you or anyone you support is <u>eligible for pension credit</u> and how much you could get if they are pension age.

More income and planning spending

Wokingham Citizens Advice has tools to help you <u>maximise your income and planning your spending</u> if you're struggling.

Where to go to stay warm

<u>Warm spaces are up and running across the borough</u> organised by community groups. Earley, Shinfield, Spencers Wood and Wokingham have support in place, we'll be adding more as they open up. All libraries are open to provide support this winter too.

If you're struggling and worried about marking Christmas for your family, local organisations can help you. We've pulled together <u>help at Christmas with organisations who may be able to support you.</u>

Warmer winters

The <u>partnership winter warmers project</u> is providing items to those who need them to help reduce bills at home.

Low energy items like slow cookers, air fryers and heated blankets, along with warm clothes, blankets and more. The project is run alongside SHARE Wokingham, First Days Children's Charity and our Hardship Alliance partners.

Apply through First Days or a charity you already work with.

Grants for essentials

Our Hardship Alliance partners Wokingham United Charities have its <u>Essential Item Grant</u> open for the winter. This is eligible to Wokingham Borough residents to help with items like furniture or white goods if you're in hardship, services to reduce distress or fees associated with debts.

£120 Household Support Fund grants

If you're struggling to pay bills or buy food this winter our <u>Household Support Fund</u> can help you with £120 towards costs. There's specific money put aside for all families with children who receive means-tested free school meals. <u>How to apply can be found on our website</u>.

Loan sharks

Watch out for loan sharks in the run up to Christmas

Lenders are looking to cash in as people struggling to cope with rising costs of food, fuel and energy, as well as the costs of the festive period

Advice is available from Stop Loan Sharks if you have borrowed from a loan shark or are worried about someone else.

Walter's Pantry

We have a fully stocked pantry for our children and their families; if you come to school (at any time) you are welcome to take the items you need to provide healthy (easy to prepare) meals for your children (at no cost). You can come as often as you need to. Bring a bag and fill it up. If you forget your bag we have those too. Please feel able to come during the school day for privacy if you prefer.



Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one sessions, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
