In this book

Your child will practise these key sounds:

- ew** (as in Andrews)
- ue/u-e/u** (as in rescue/tunes/music)
- u/oul** (as in pushed/should)
- ear** (as in pearls)
- ou** (as in cloudy)
- oy** (as in enjoying)
- our/au/augh/aw** (as in tour/applauded/daughter/strawberries)

Reading tip

Ask your child to think of a different ending to a new or familiar story. This will help them to develop their imagination and to engage more with the story.

Before reading

Before you begin, talk about the front cover and blurb together. Ask your child: *What is a garden party? Have you ever been to a garden party or picnic?*

While reading

- ★ If your child has trouble reading a sentence, re-read it to them. This will help them to understand the meaning.
- ★ After reading page 6, ask your child who the intruder is and what they think might happen next.
- ★ Read the dialogue on page 7 to your child with expression, then ask them to read it in the same way.
- ★ Stop occasionally to talk about the details in the illustrations, such as the mice at the bottom of page 9.

After reading, encourage your child to talk about the story. You'll find ideas for questions and activities on page 21. →
