## **Online safety**

Date published: 24 April 2025

Ofcom has published the final version of its Protection of Children Codes and Guidance which will apply to providers of online services and platforms likely to be used by UK children. The child safety measures, designed to help protect children and young people from harmful content online, will require relevant providers of online services to complete and record children's risk assessments by 24 July 2025. From 25 July 2025, they should apply the safety measures set out in Ofcom's Codes to mitigate these risks. The safety measures include: safer feeds, with algorithms configured to filter out harmful content from children; effective age checks; and all sites and apps must have processes in place to review, assess and quickly tackle harmful content when they become aware of it. If companies fail to comply with their duties under the Online Safety Act, Ofcom has the power to impose fines and in serious cases, can apply for a court order to prevent the site or app from being available in the UK. There are five volumes setting out Ofcom's decisions, together with a number of regulatory documents and guidance.














But...

We would like to invite parents and carers to attend a meeting to find out more about the Phonics Screening Check in Year 1. The check will take place in the week beginning Monday 9th June 2025. If your year 2 child did not meet the benchmark last year, they will have a second chance this year.

We will be leading a workshop for Parents and Carers on Monday 12th May at 2:30 pm in the school hall.


This will be an opportunity for us to share information about the screening check, our arrangements that will be in place in school and how you can support your child at home.

We will place the workshop PowerPoint on the website at the end of the meeting for those who cannot attend.

If a child is absent during the check week (9th ~ 13th June); we can administer the check with our pupils until Friday 20th June 2025. Any child who is absent from school for this entire period will be recorded as absent when we submit the data for the phonics screening check. Please ensure your child comes to school during this time period unless they are too unwell.

If you have a child in your family who has already completed the check and you attended a previous meeting; the content of the meeting has not changed, but we would love to see as many of you as possible.

#### We can help!

If you are struggling to provide anything essential for your child's well-being, such as pyjamas, coats, shoes, socks, underwear, school uniform, bedding etc please ask us as we are here to help. We do not want any of our children to miss out on the basic fundamentals that they are all entitled to. As before, please just ask.

## **Pupil Premium Funding**

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one nurture, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.

- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
