

Dear Walter Families,

Class Closures at Walter

This week we have had to close two classes for 48 hours; we closed Woodpecker Class on Monday afternoon and reopened on Thursday. We closed Pine Class on Thursday morning and will reopen on Monday (just in time for the reindeer)!

We had reached the outbreak management stage of 10% of a close group e.g. class. We asked the parents to take their children to have a PCR test. After 48 hours the children from Woodpecker started to return; 7 children had a positive PCR test in Woodpecker. So far 7 children have a positive PCR test in Pine so we are pleased we made the decisions we did as they could have escalated far further if the classes had remained open.

Please be vigilant at all times:

- Do not send your child to school if they are poorly
- If they have a runny nose and other cold symptoms, please arrange a PCR test or isolate for 10 days
- If they have a high temperature, please arrange a PCR test or isolate for 10 days
- If they have a positive LFT test, please arrange a PCR test or isolate for 10 days

<u>Please do not delay</u> in letting us know the test results; we need to know when we reach outbreak point.

Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one sessions, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

1) Income Support.

2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.

3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.

4) Child Tax Credit - Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.

5) Guarantee Pension Credit.

- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
