Larch: Queen Bryony and King Leart

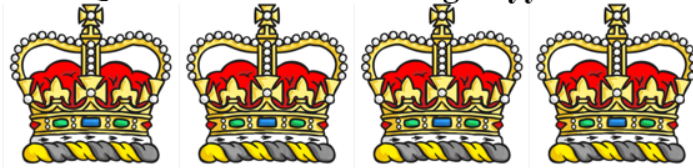
Oak: King Luke and Queen Emma-Rose

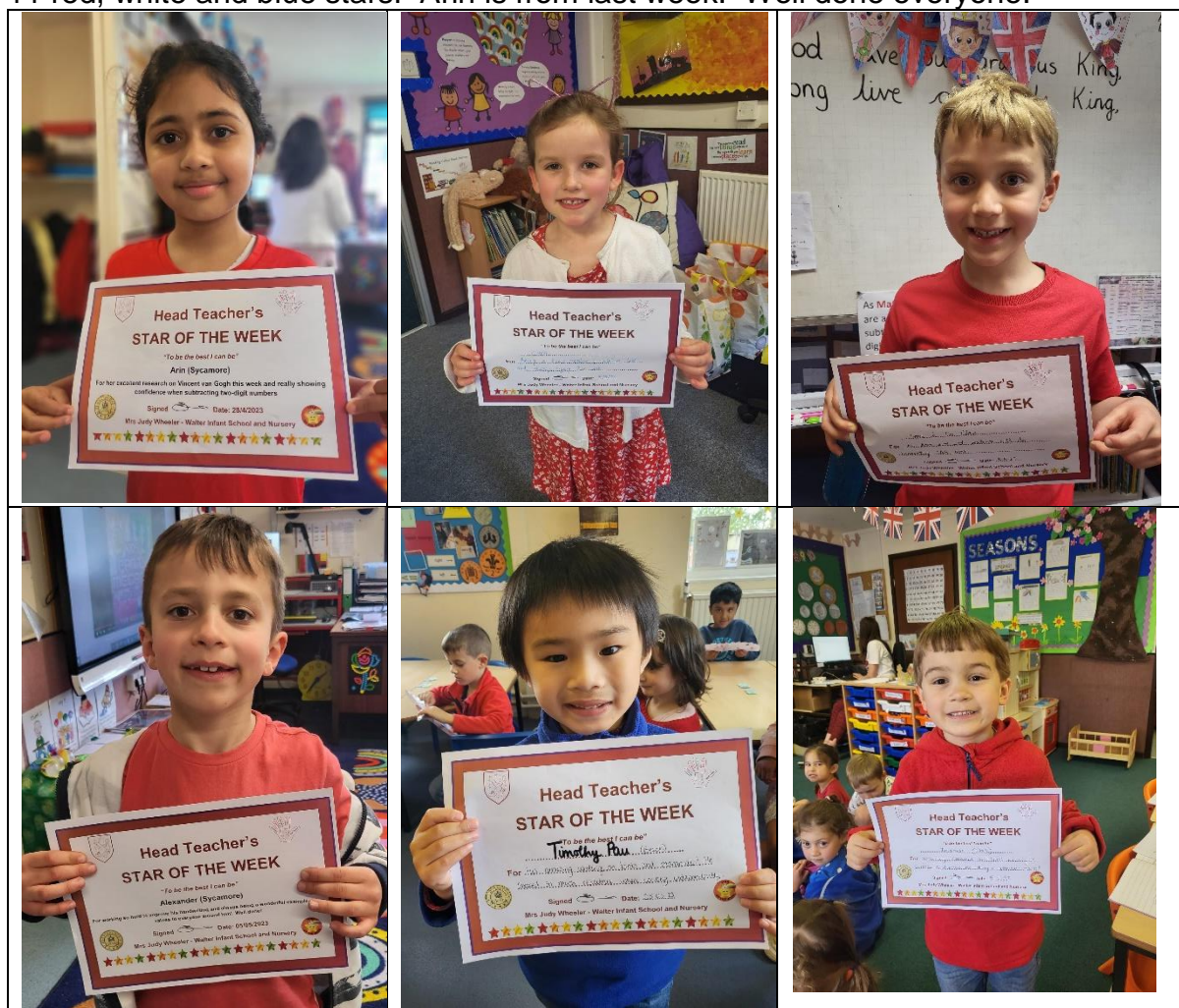
Walter's Pantry

Our pantry is nearly empty, it is being used regularly by our families and is a wonderful support to many. If you would like to contribute, these are the things that we need the most:

- Cereal (that children enjoy), e.g. Rice Crispies, Weetabix (but own brand)
- Long life milk
- Tins of soup
- Tinned meals, e.g. ravioli, macaroni cheese, meatballs etc
- Bags of pasta
- Tinned tomatoes and tinned vegetables.
- Packets of biscuits
- Pasta Sauce
- Tinned meat or fish

We can help!

If you are struggling to provide anything essential for your child's well-being, such as pyjamas, coats, shoes, socks, underwear, school uniform, bedding etc please ask us as we are here to help. We do not want any of our children to miss out on the basic fundamentals that they are all entitled to. As before, please just ask. Don't forget about Walter's Pantry.

Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provide curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one sessions, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit - Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
