Rough Play and Fighting

You will have seen the email that I sent out about rough play and fighting; I have spoken to the children as clearly as I can at an age appropriate level, about the importance of respecting the right of other children to feel safe and secure within school (inside and outside the classroom). From now on, children who show that they cannot play safely, will have to play separately from the other children for at least one session, so that they can begin to understand the impact it has on them if they hurt others. Every child voted that they did not want rough play in school. We will be ordering some new signs to remind everyone.

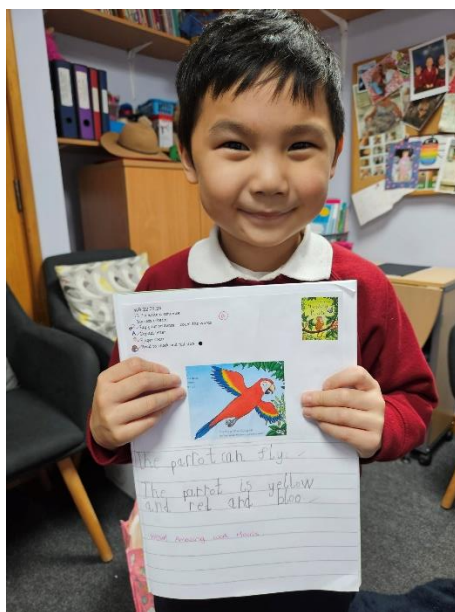

Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one nurture, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit - Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.

- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
