#### Parking at West Oak

I have received a very serious complaint from West Oak, the Nursing Home opposite St Paul's gates, where my mum actually lives and some of our parents work!

They have noticed that parents/carers from both schools have been parking in their car park (again)! I was very disappointed to read about an incident that they have needed to share with Mrs Janes via email.

I am writing to raise a concern that has recently come to my attention. We have noticed an increasing number of parents using our car park during school drop-off and pick-up times. Unfortunately, this is creating significant safety concerns, as it can block access for emergency vehicles and delay urgent care for our residents, many of whom are elderly, frail, and could need immediate medical attention.

In one incident yesterday, a member of our team politely informed a parent that parking on our premises is not permitted. Regrettably, the response was aggressive and included inappropriate language directed at our staff member. While we understand that parking around schools can be challenging, we kindly ask for your assistance in addressing this issue.

We would be grateful if you could communicate with parents to remind them not to use our car park and to treat all our staff with courtesy and respect. Continued incidents of abusive behaviour may need to be reported to the appropriate authorities, which we hope to avoid.

I am hopeful that any of our families who have been parking at West Oak will now refrain from doing so.

We do not want any of our children to miss out on the basic fundamentals that they are all entitled to. As before, please just ask.

#### Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one nurture, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

1) Income Support.

2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.

3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.

4) Child Tax Credit - Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.

5) Guarantee Pension Credit.

6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.

7) Universal Credit.
