	<p>Night Monkey, Day Monkey Explore nocturnal animals – sorting Labelling animals – phonetically plausible</p>
	<p>Stickman Explore the words used in the story – rhyming words Continue a rhyming string Find matching rhyming pairs</p>
	<p>Christmas Write Christmas lists Label stockings (cvc) Christmas cards</p>
