Four days a week, quite a large group of children from all year groups attend a Sensory Circuits session in the school hall at the start of the day. A few weeks ago a specialist from Foundry visited the school and was so impressed by our circuits and our wonderful children, saying it was the best Sensory Circuits session she had ever seen and asking if she could send other professionals to school to see our sessions in action; the following has been written by Mrs Bell after once such visit yesterday:

This week we had Jenny Chapman, an Early Years Advisor from Wokingham Borough Council, visit us in school. She looked around our school and was very complimentary of all of our learning spaces, commenting on how she could clearly see the purpose for each area. The basis of Jenny's visit was to see sensory circuits; she saw the setup, the children in action as well as the

clearing away of it. Jenny was in awe of what she saw - the children demonstrated they knew exactly what they were doing and all completed their circuit with enthusiasm and resilience. Jenny commented on how it is evident all members of staff work together to ensure the children's needs are met in a timely and efficient manner. We are so proud of our team!


Year 2 Photographs

Here are our amazing stars of the week; all of these children have shone brightly and tried to be the best that they can be.










Amazing work in school

Ashleigh received her star of the week certificate for writing the most amazing acrostic poem; well done Ashleigh!




Empathy

We do not want any of our children to miss out on the basic fundamentals that they are all entitled to. As before, please just ask.

Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one nurture, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
