Fuel Bank

If you're struggling to pay your energy bills, contact your energy provider first as they may be able to help.

Many people have to make the difficult choice between heating their home and putting a meal on the table, because they are unable to afford to do both. As a result, people in this situation do not top up their pre-payment meters, leaving them without gas and electricity for cooking, heating and hot water. Wokingham Foodbank operates a Fuel bank scheme to provide support for Wokingham Borough Council residents who are unable to afford energy costs.
