

Dear Walter Families,

This has been a very turbulent week; filled with massive highs and huge lows. As you may know our Sycamore Bubble has closed; sadly we will not be able to say a proper farewell to our wonderful Sycamore children but there will be a Zoom Call next week. Sycamore Class have been amazing all year and we will miss them all so much.

Sadly also, Miss Prickett has to isolate due to track and trace so is unable to be with Magpie Class for the last few days of term!

You may also know that St Paul's have closed bubbles and isolating staff too. As do so many other school in Wokingham and nationwide, so we cannot stop taking precautionary measures. Mrs Taylor and I have agreed on this message for both schools:

The number of Covid-19 cases in our borough is increasing, the impact of which is being felt across our two schools, with class bubbles having to close and a growing number of additional pupils and staff having to self-isolate. It has been heart breaking to send pupils and staff home who will not be returning before the end of term, many of whom are due to be leaving our schools next week.

In consultation with Governors, and for the safety of our pupils, their families and our staff, we will be maintaining all of our existing control measures up until the end of the term. You will appreciate how disappointed we are that we have to change some of our plans for our leavers and transition arrangements for all of our children, including the Y2 to Y3 pupils. To ensure that our schools remain as fully open as possible, we are asking all parents to do the following:

- If you believe that you or your child may have COVID 19 symptoms, including cold/hayfever symptoms, a sore throat, headache or temperature, please do not risk the safety of other pupils and staff by sending your child to school. Arrange for a PCR test, only sending your child back once a negative result has been received.
- If you believe you or your child may have had extended contact with an adult or child who has a positive PCR test result, please do not risk the safety of others by sending them in. They should self-isolate for a period of 10 days;
- If you, your child or anyone else within your household receives a positive Lateral Flow Test result, please do not send your child to school until you receive a negative PCR test result.

The safety of our school communities comes before everything and whilst COVID 19 can be mild or present with no symptoms, for some, including children, it can be a dreadful illness with far reaching consequences.
