The impact of COVID 19

I have been very impressed with the courteous behaviour of all our parents and children on and around our site and thank you for ensuring that you are socially distancing as much as you possibly can. I think we are all getting better and better! This is Mr Fennell; he is our site controller and responsible for ensuring the safety of everyone at the start and end of the school day. If he politely asks you to move it is because he feels that the area is not safe, so please could I ask that you follow his directions. Thank you.



Due to the current situation we are changing the way we would like you to report an absence.

If you need to report an absence, please send an email to this new address: <u>absences@walter.wokingham.sch.uk</u> by 9.00am at the latest?

- If your child has either a cough or temperature (37.8 degrees or above), they will need to self-isolate for 10 days.
- If your child is self-isolating for 10 days and they have a sibling, the sibling will need to self-isolate for 14 days as per government guidelines.
- If you get your child tested and the result is negative, your child can return back to school **if they no longer have symptoms**.
- If further symptoms develop, there will be a need to isolate again and a further test may be appropriate.

What to do if a pupil is displaying symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19)

We have published a list of actions that early years, schools and further education colleges must follow in the event that a child or young person displays symptoms or if they confirm they have tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19). Passwords

We are setting up a password system; If you are unable to collect your child for any reason, you will be asked to provide a password that we will store in your child's records. Whenever a different adult collects your child they will be asked to share the password with your child's teacher; if they do not know the password we will not allow your child to leave. We will only ever let your children leave with an adult; that means a person of 18 years or older.

Wrap Around Care

We have all our wraparound care facilities in place to ensure that your children can be safely taken care of in a secure and supportive environment from 7:30 am until 6:00 pm.

The day begins with our Rise and Shine Club led by Mrs Hemmings; this is a lovely calm and quiet start to the day, the children bring their breakfast and have the opportunity to play, draw, colour, read and chat until the school day begins. The session costs £5.50 per day.

In Robin, we have a lunch club for our 30 hours children; if you would like your child to attend at the beginning or end of your child's time in Robin the can remain at school until 12:30 pm or come into school at 11:30 am. The will need to bring their own lunch (as all Robin's do) and the session costs £5.50 per day. If you would like your 30 hours child to stay till 3:30 pm you can pay for an additional hour at school for £5.50 per day. The places are filling up fast. As a school we are very reliant on our PTA for fundraising to buy the extra resources and fun items that the budget doesn't always allow for; PLEASE help us by joining our PTA and helping to support the school and raise funds. Pupil Premium Funding

If you experiencing financial hard ship please get in touch with us; we may be able to help. If you have had a change to your circumstances, your child may be entitled to Pupil Premium Funding? If you contact Mrs Janes or Mrs Hemmings in the office they will be able to send you a form to complete. If your family are eligible, we will be able to register you for the Free School Meals Voucher Scheme which is £15 per child.

You may be able to claim if you are in receipt of:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

The Pupil Premium for 2019 to 2020 will include pupils recorded in the January 2019 school census who are known to have been eligible for FSM since May 2013, as well as those first known to be eligible at January 2019.

There is always a very quick response and when you hear back we should be able to register you in time for the summer holidays.
