Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) is additional government funding available to the childcare provider your child attends for their free entitlement for 3 and 4 year olds. You will need to meet certain criteria for your child to be eligible. The EYPP will be used to support your child's development by providing additional learning opportunities.
