Working in Partnership

As we draw to the end of our second week of the term we have noticed a few things that we need to remind everyone about:

School Drop Off from 8:30 am

We open the school gates at 8:30 am but the children do not need to come into the playground until 8:40 am. The teachers in Key Stage 1 come out to greet the children at 8:40 am. Children must not be left on our school site unaccompanied; we have been made aware that some parents and carers are leaving as soon as they have walked their children through the gate.

The Climbing Frame

Please do not let your children play on the climbing frame or the climbing wall at the start and end of the day. They will have plenty of opportunities to play during the school day. If your child is playing on other equipment, such as the train, you must supervise them. Thank you.

Snacks in the Playground

Please do not give your children food in the playground at the end of the day; please wait until you leave the school site. Not all children have snacks, it leads to an increase in litter and the food that falls onto the ground encourages rats and pigeons to visit. We pride ourselves on our status of being a Healthy School and a

sustainable school so please show your support by saving the snacks for the journey home or even when you get home.

Parking

There is no doubt that parking is an issue at the start and end of the school day; however, parents and carers must not park in the car park of Murray House or at West Oak. There were so many cars in the private car park of Murray House yesterday at the end of the school day and people were manoeuvring all over the place, with little care for safety; a staff member witnessed adults arguing in front of the children and becoming aggressive. You will see from these photographs, that parking is prohibited in some areas around the school and no-one has the right to park on private property. We will be monitoring the situation with support from Wokingham Borough Council.



Accidental Injuries away from School

Since the start of term, we have had a lot of children coming into school with accidental injuries which have occurred when they are not in school. If your child has an accident which results in a fracture, stitches, a bump, bruises, grazes or scratches you must inform their class teacher as soon as possible, for example via email before the start of the next school day or when bringing your child into school in the morning, when you can inform me or Mrs Bell, or the class teacher. We will need to know the nature and place of injury, any restrictions on your child's mobility and other information that we need to be aware of. If we see an injury that has not been reported, we will contact you for further information.

Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one nurture, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
