



World Blood Donor Day 14th June 2024 World Blood Donor Day (who.int)



Today is World Blood Donor Day; donating blood is one of the most generous things a person can do in their life time. It only takes a little while, it doesn't hurt, you get a biscuit and a cup of tea and save lives, all at the same time. There is a huge shortage of blood, especially O+, which is the most popular blood type at 38% of the population. There is also a shortage of blood donations from people of colour in the UK. My life was saved in 1987 by a blood transfusion; I received 9 pints of blood in 48 hours! After that, I became a blood donor, so did my brother, he went on to be a gold award winning donor. Unfortunately. I had to stop donating blood in the early 2000s because of the risk of my blood being contaminated, which you will have being hearing a lot about lately. Luckily for me, I do not have contaminated blood, but even so, I am still not allowed to donate. Other members of my family still donate blood, and you could too!
