







It has been so very wet and windy; with the most unpleasant downpours this week. Some of children have not had coats. Please ensure that your child has a coat in school every day. Please do NOT bring umbrellas into school. Your child will not be able to use it and we have had one or two very near misses this week.

Charity Donations

As many of you know, we raise money for local and national charities as part of our Character Education: How well do we promote the value of volunteering and service to others? As our children are so young, we feel taking part in local and national charity initiatives enables them to provide a service for others. Charity Donations also form part of our Values Curriculum; empathy, respect and kindness. This term we will be raising money for three charities Jeans for Genes Day on Friday 23rd September, when we ask the children to come in their jeans instead of school uniform. A non-uniform day on Friday 30th September for WADE (Wokingham and District Association for the Elderly) and Christmas Jumper Day for Save the Children in December. On each occasion we request a small donation per child, usually £1 BUT we fully understand that with the rising costs of fuel, very high inflation and the cost of living crisis, that every £1 counts. So please do not feel the need to donate, but we would love it if your children still take part in each event.

Walter's Pantry

We have a pantry in school stocked with breakfast cereal, pasta, rice and tins of food which can be cooked on the hob or in the microwave; if you are struggling to put a meal on the table at any time, please let the school office know and we can arrange a suitable, discrete time for you to come and fill a shopping bag.

Foodbank and Fuel Vouchers

Mrs Janes in the school office will be able to support you in getting Food Vouchers for a home delivery if you are struggling to make ends meet (as many of our families are). We are also able to help with fuel vouchers, but for pre-paid metres only. If you are having problems in providing elements of our school uniform; please get in touch with us immediately. Naming Uniform and Kits



Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one sessions, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
