We will be leading a workshop for Parents and Carers on Monday 12th May at 2:30 pm in the school hall.


This will be an opportunity for us to share information about the screening check, our arrangements that will be in place in school and how you can support your child at home.

We will place the workshop PowerPoint on the website at the end of the meeting for those who cannot attend.

If a child is absent during the check week (9th ~ 13th June); we can administer the check with our pupils until Friday 20th June 2025. Any child who is absent from school for this entire period will be recorded as absent when we submit the data for the phonics screening check. Please ensure your child comes to school during this time period unless they are too unwell.

If you have a child in your family who has already completed the check and you attended a previous meeting; the content of the meeting has not changed, but we would love to see as many of you as possible.

Player of the Season, William C was nominated for Coaches Award and Archie was nominated for Player of the Season and Most Improved Player. Well done all of you!



Lunchtime Activities

Starting on Monday (28th April 2025) we will be implementing some significant changes to our lunchtime arrangements; we will be running an indoor club for playing games and colouring and drawing activities. There will be a Lego club, once a week and a yoga club on Fridays. We will have more adults playing with the children, teaching them playground games and new skills, such as hula hooping and skipping. And the reading garden will be open and run by an adult, who will read with or to the children. I will take some photographs and publish them in the flyer next week. We are making these changes to reduce the number of incidents of rough play on the playground and on the pitch. We will limit the numbers of children inside to the capacity of the space being used. Most activities will take place in our Learning Hub. Mrs Adams-Price will be running a gardening club twice a week and we have just received 30 watering cans, lots of gardening gloves and forks, trowels and rakes. If you would like to donate plants or seeds, we would be delighted to receive them.

We do not want any of our children to miss out on the basic fundamentals that they are all entitled to. As before, please just ask.

Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one nurture, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

1) Income Support.

- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
